•Catholic Schools Week...

- A celebration of the value of Catholic education.
 - It focuses on the gift that Catholic education provides to young people, the Church, our community, and our nation.

- It builds community awareness of and involvement in Catholic schools.
 - It honors those who contribute to the success of Catholic schools, including students, families, faculty and staff, volunteers, community supporters, and local and national leaders.

Catholic Schools Week is celebrated annually & nationally, beginning with the last Sunday in January

- 2017 Theme is *Catholic Schools: Communities of Faith, Knowledge, and Service*.
- The theme encompasses several concepts that are at the heart of a Catholic education. First, schools are communities—small families in their own right, but also members of the larger community of home, church, city and nation. Faith, knowledge and service are three measures by which any Catholic school can and should be judged.
- The logo features a swirl of colors interacting around a cross, which is at the center of all Catholic education. The vibrancy of the colors and the movement and shadows in the logo portray the inner-connectivity and community life that are present in our Catholic schools.
